

DAVID ANTHONY HALLAM

Dave, born 17 July 1945, was with Keyworth briefly in 1964 before returning in 1977 to begin a long association with the club both on and off the field, playing until 2009 and then serving on the committee as Club Treasurer for a number of years and always a regular spectator on match days, and a Vice President since 2010.

A barrell chested fireman affectionately known as 'The Sheriff' he was a right arm fast medium bowler and a prolific wicket taker who conceded few runs and was a very useful hard hitting lower order batsman.

Dave is the third highest wicket taker in the history of the club at all levels, 1st XI, 2nd XI and Evening League with 628 victims and ranks 21st among 1st XI bowlers.
