KEITH J HODGETT



Keith was born in Plumtree on 15 November 1932 and progressed through the junior section of the club and developed into a consistently reliable medium fast bowler over many years, amassing over 400 wickets in a career with the club lasting from 1948 to 1971.

Only average in height, he generated a lively bowling pace from a short run up and could pick up good lower order runs with some vigorous hitting. He won the Webster Bowling Cup in 1957 and the Batting trophy in 1959

A loyal clubman, Keith captained the 2nd XI and was Fixture Secretary in the 1960's and has maintained contact with the club long after his playing days and remains a Vice President to this present day.

His best bowling performances were 8 wickets for 33 runs in a 2nd XI match against Colwick Railways CC 2nds on July 2nd 1949 and 7 for 14 against Kimberley Institute CC in a Notts Amateur League Division 2 match at home on 16th July 1960. He took more than 5 wickets in an innings on ten occasions and he lies in 7th place on the all time list of 1st XI wicket takers

for the club.

Keith married Sylvia the daughter of William 'Billy' Gunn (pictured right), himself a stalwart of the club for many years as both player (1921 to 1948) and administrator, a club trophy still exists in his name.

A winger, Keith played from 1949 to 1962 for Keyworth United Football Club, following in the footsteps of his father Gerald Hodgett, a full back with the club during the 1920's.
