Review of the Season:

The Annual General Meeting took place on 6 January 1959 in the Lecture Room.

The Annual Dinner took place in Loughborough on 21 March 1959 at the Bulls Head PH.

Highlights of the season included two hat tricks, one by Ron Armstrong for the 1st XI in a League match against Eastwood St Marys on 22 August in a 6 for 13 spell and earlier in the season, John Stubbs taking the first recorded club hat trick, on 9 May in a 2nd XI match versus Bingham. John finished with figures of 5 for 7. The season also witnessed the highest batting partnership since the 2nd World War when Charlie Underwood and Gerald Starbuck put on 124 for the 7th wicket against Raleigh Athletic on 1 August.

The 1st XI having been promisingly placed near the top for most of the season fell away at the end for only a top half finish.
