Review of the Season:



Alan Copson stood down after a record 14 years as President of the club at the AGM held at the Village Hall on Friday 11 January 2008. The photo shows Dave Hallam (Treasurer), Richard Drury (Chairman), Cliff Anderson (Secretary) & Chris Ladd (Social Secretary) doing their preparation.

The 1st XI were playing in the 2nd highest level of Club Cricket in Nottinghamshire, only the 12 team Nottinghamshire Cricket Board Premier League stood above them, but despite a big squad of players "on paper" we consistently struggled to field 22 players each Saturday and the 1st XI on average missed between 4 and 6 first choice players almost every match through a combination of job commitments; dad's required to perform child minding duties; holidays; stag weekends; weddings and injuries and the step up in class, having to compete week in week out against club's with professional players proved too much and even in the close finishes we missed out. Star batsman Ian Graham did not fire on all cylinders and the usual big haul of wickets from Rob Baker deserted him. Grant Parker was our most consistent batsman and we lost him in mid season back to his home in Oueensland, Australia.

For the 2nd XI, Chairman, Richard Drury continued to accumulate runs consistently and evergreen Ernie Lay in his 32nd season for the club, edged his way past the career 10,000 runs mark, whilst John Beeton (now eligible to collect his state pension) continued to turn his arm over to good effect when asked. Led by skipper Ted Elliott (when he was not helping the 1st XI) and vice captain Andy Cowlard (who enjoyed a good season with the ball) the team had to chop and change their line up to accommodate 1st XI demands, yet still performed confidently and consistently and they were champions of their division in all but name, having been denied the title through a highly controversial 8 point penalty deduction.

Off the field of play we increased the number of Vice Presidents and gained the financial support of 14 sponsors during the season, acquired a Pitch Cover, installed ball stop fencing at the bottom end of the ground and re-painted and re-fitted all the dressing room accommodation in club colours. For the third successive season we staged an eventful and enjoyable Twenty20 match on August Bank Holiday Monday and for the first time in many seasons re-introduced Junior Cricket to the club through the staging of an 8 school Cricket Festival, followed by regular coaching sessions, assisted by former England &

Nottinghamshire CCC super star Derek Randall, culminating in a Ten10 competition. A Golf Day was staged at Stanton on the Wolds GC and cricket was provided for non regulars through a series of Sunday Friendlies and for the second successive season we went on tour, this time to Somerset where heavy rain prevented both matches from even starting, but a good time was had.






