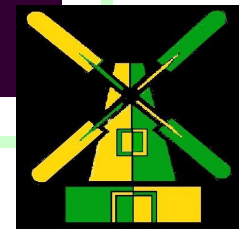
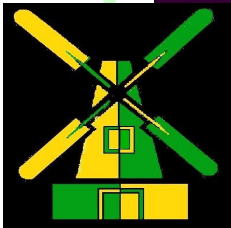

Best friend in Sport: His Power Caddy...

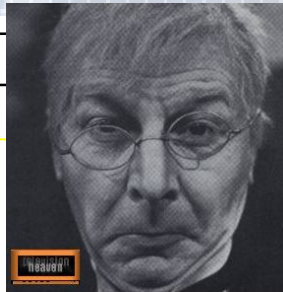
Favourite film: Caddyshack; Ghost
